

COVID-19 UPDATE June 2020

After meeting with our deacons and church council members it has been decided to begin Sunday morning worship services again. We will begin Sunday, June 7th, at 10 a.m.. You will be asked to follow all the county health guidelines as we meet together for worship. Which means:

If you are sick or are uncomfortable meeting with a group of people at this time please stay home. The safety and health of our church needs to be everyone's priority. We will continue to live stream the service, with the live stream beginning at 10:30.

You will be asked to follow the 6 foot social distancing rule. Only families may sit together. All children must be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian and they must sit together for the service.

Masks are recommended, but not required. If you would like a mask, but you do not have one, the church will have a mask available for you to use.

You are asked to refrain from shaking hands or hugging one another.

Please feel free to use the hand sanitizers at the 5 hand sanitizer stations located throughout the building.

You may place your tithes and offerings in the offering plates that are on the Lord Supper table in the entry way.

You are asked not to leave the building until you have been dismissed by the pastor at the end of the service. Please exit the building once you are dismissed.

We believe if these guidelines are followed that we can provide a safe and healthy environment for us to be able to gather as a church family once again.
